

The Green Activities Audit Description

Green Activities is a sustainability program based on commitment to continuous improvement by the applicant. Achieving the certificate requires meeting the Green Activities criteria, and adherence to them is ensured by regular audits.

Besides checking that all relevant criteria are met, the audit provides an opportunity for exchanging ideas about the establishment's sustainability work and future plans for developing it, discussing the goals of participating in the Green Activities program, and planning ways of communicating all this to the customers.

The audit lasts approximately 2 hours (3 hours for establishments that offer tourism animal activities). The audit is carried out by Going Green Oy staff or by an authorised, external auditor. If the establishment has facilities in several locations, the audit may take longer. Depending on the type of establishment, the Green Activities audit may take place either online or on-site (establishments that offer activity programs using tourism animals).

The contents of the audit

In the audit, the following topics will be reviewed/ discussed:

- The application
 - We go through the application and the required attachments
 - We discuss
 - Your past/future sustainability goals and plans on how to achieve them
 - Your objectives for participating in the Green Activities program
 - Your plan on sustainability induction and training of staff
 - Your sustainability communication to guests
- The Green Activities binder
- Visual inspection (either on-line or on-site)
 - Communal areas (visibility of sustainability communication/ the Green Activities certificate)
 - o Waste management and recycling facilities and instructions
 - o In establishments with tourism animals, the following facilities/equipment will also be checked:
 - Enclosures/housing where tourism animals are kept
 - Sleighs, harnesses, feeds etc.
 - Runs, convalescing/whelping spaces, storage rooms
 - Equipment used for transporting the animals
 - Areas/facilities used for collecting manure
 - Other facilities referred to in the criteria



The certification process

Before an audit may take place, the applicant fills in the application form which is processed and checked by Going Green Oy. In each application, all the imperative criteria must be met. In addition, starting from the first re-application, an annually growing number of guideline criteria must be met.

Based on the audit, the auditor writes an audit report that is sent to the applicant and Going Green Oy. If the audit report confirms that all the necessary criteria are met, certification is granted by the Green Key jury (establishments audited by a member of Going Green Oy staff) or the external auditor. This procedure ensures equitable and unbiased treatment of all applicants. The jury consists of national representatives of tourism business and sustainability experts. In line with Green Key's international audit regulations, Going Green also uses external, independent auditors. All external auditors have extensive tourism field experience and expertise on developing sustainable tourism. The currently authorised external auditors are presented on our website (Contact us > External auditors).

The Green Key program is run in Finland by Going Green Oy which is a social enterprise fully owned by the Finnish Association for Environmental Education (FEE ry).
